

**TEMPORARY REGULATION CERTIFICATE
ENVIRONMENT CANTERBURY NAVIGATION SAFETY BYLAWS 2010
PART 7.2 .1 (b) (c) and (d)**

Coast to Coast is hereby granted temporary reservation of the Upper Waimakariri River from Mount White bridge to the Waimakariri River Gorge Bridge for the annual Coast to Coast race under Part 7.2 1 (b) (c) and (d) of the Environment Canterbury Navigation Safety Bylaws 2010 subject to the following.

Period: From 2100 hours on Friday 12th February 2016 until 0600 hours on Sunday 14th February 2016

Purpose: To reserve the area for use by race competitor kayaks and the race organiser's support and safety craft including kayaks and jet boats associated with the event. All other jet boats other than commercial craft usually operating in this location, all other craft including power craft, non-race kayaks (including those of competitors no longer in the race) and rafts, tubes or other non-powered craft shall be prohibited.

Regulated/Reserved Area: All that part of the Waimakariri River from 100m upstream of the Mount White Bridge in the Upper Waimakariri River to 100m downstream of the Waimakariri Gorge Bridge near Sheffield.

Regulation/Reservation: Except for commercial jet boats usually operating in this location or in the case of a genuine emergency, no craft of any kind shall enter into or navigate within the reserved area during the period of the reservation without first having been granted the express permission of the Reserved Area Controller or an Environment Canterbury Harbourmaster.

Conditions: Notice of this temporary reservation shall be made public by way of appropriate websites (in particular the Coast to Coast website) signage and media, and directly to representatives of known affected user groups, during the week preceding the event as a minimum.

Notices of the reservation shall be displayed at the following locations from Thursday 4th February 2016, and removed the day following the event:

- At the launching ramp on the Waimakariri River immediately upstream of the SH1 bridges.
- Alongside the access road into the Woodstock launching area where it can best be seen.
- At the access route to the river at the Waimakariri Gorge Bridge.
- At any other locations routinely used for launching of powered or non-powered craft.

A copy of this certificate shall be carried by marshals and other event staff who are in a position to advise other river users of the reservation.

Those in support and safety boats and kayaks are to wear appropriate PFDs at all times, and the vessels are to be fully equipped for their safety role.

The holder of this temporary regulation certificate shall undertake all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all persons involved in the race.

This reservation will not have effect if the Waimakariri River Gorge leg of the race is cancelled.
